MAKING YOUR CONFESSION

When you come to make your confession, and have knelt down and said “Forgive me Father, for I have sinned”: the next thing to do is to express your state of life. For example, I would say: “It's one week since my last Confession, and I am a Catholic Priest, and these are my sins.” You might say, “I'm a single/married man/woman... in my 20s, 30s... it's been one week since my last Confession and these are my sins.” The reason for doing this is that it places the Confession into the perspective of your life – and helps the priest to understand better what and why you are confessing. And don't be afraid of telling the priest why you believe particular sins are occurring: you may be unwell, away from home, stressed, lonely, the middle of exams, financially stretched. Being precise will enable you to make a good confession – and enables the priest to understand and help you.

ADOREMUS EUCCHARISTIC CONGRESS: 7 – 9 SEPTEMBER

The Echo Arena in Liverpool – which can accommodate 10,000 pilgrims – will be the home to a six-hour stage programme on the 8th September and will include a Congress Mass, keynote speakers **Bishop Robert Barron** and **Vincent Cardinal Nichols**, and a drama highlighting the beauty of reverence and devotion. Also state that you or your relative would like the Roman Catholic Chaplain to visit you. Chaplains visit the wards during the week and provide an on-call service in case of emergency.
